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Articles should not exceed 6000 words. Submissions should be sent as an MS e-mail attachment to Armela Panajoti (armelap@assenglish.org) or Marsela Turku (mturku@assenglish.org).

Please include a 250-word abstract and 4-5 keywords. Submissions should conform to the 16th edition of The Chicago Manual of Style. *in esse* uses a "References" format together with author-date-page citations in the body of the article. Spelling should conform to *The Oxford English Dictionary* except for cited material.
